Human Microchip Protection

"Microchip" means any device, including but not limited to radio frequency identification (RFID) or near-field communication (NFC) technology, that is implanted under the skin of a human being for the purpose of identification, tracking, data storage, or communication.

"Private entity" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, or other legal entity that is not a government agency.

"Healthcare facility" means any hospital, clinic, medical office, or other facility licensed to provide medical care or treatment in the Commonwealth.

No private entity or healthcare facility operating within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall implant, or cause to be implanted, a microchip in any human being.

Nothing in this act shall prohibit a resident of Pennsylvania from voluntarily receiving a microchip implant outside the geographic boundaries of the Commonwealth.

A violation of this act shall constitute a misdemeanor of the second degree. Each unauthorized implantation shall be considered a separate offense.
